Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Brad Pellissier at 7:00pm.

Pepsi Representative , John Foxx was introduced and the May 3rd event was discussed.

Birkenshaw Electric will donate electric work. Running lines from Lodge to Caretaker and other buildings on site. Pepsi will provide help.

Committee members will be captains of each building as well as outside work.

Citco Company also volunteering to pick up trash in the last week of April. They will bag trash and leave it. Bags will be picked up the weekend of May 3rd.

Portable bathrooms and roll off dumpsters will be supplied

Requesting Ken to send out email to all volunteers on his list to bring gloves, shovels, rakes and other supplies needed. All items should be labeled.

Concerns from neighbors were expressed as to the process. "Why is electric being done before the project is approved?"

Brad presented map with recommendations of buildings to keep:

Hill Top, Caretaker, Avery, Restrooms cabin.

Still checking into use of small buildings behind the restroom cabin.

Steve recommended placing one side (lodge and restroom side) of the main road into the schedule of work for 2014. The opposite side of main road that includes small buildings should be scheduled for 2015.

Neighbors asked if we could put together a list of all recommendations for the public to see.

Steve suggested we recommend keeping the boathouse as storage for lake flotations equipment. It will be put up for vote at the April 17th meeting.
