Somers, Ct. Fire Marshals monthly report to Fire Commission for May 17, 2012

Today we still have problems at Demers rooming house with tenant owner disputes and bed bug infestation. This past week no hot water, because no oil in tank. Today there's oil and the hot water is turned on in second floor bathroom and is running non stop on bathroom floor and wall. Somers Fire Department will not respond without police.

Worthington Pond outing facility is installing a gas stove and ventilator hood and ductwork. He has a quote o \$2200 for a UL 300 fire suppression system.

Native American Awareness Assoc. is having a two day Indian Pow Wow at Jeff Leptons Pleasant View Golf and outing facility on south Road on June 30 and July 1st. 2012. Permit is issued for a Special Event.

In late June there are three Dance recitals and the New England baton twirling championships all at the High School. I an issuing permits for all.

So far 53 burning permits for \$1375 and 15 FM permits for \$1155. Total \$2530.

The hot dog cart at Hall and Main is legal and has FM and health dept. inspections.

I submitted a Grant request for a new Camera, and accessories to the Connecticut Fair Plan.

Note: In January 2012, both Tanker-246 and ET-146 were out of service at the same time. During this time, a structure fire occurred in town. Water capacity and delivery were significantly reduced at this fire.

In May 2012, both SQ-246 and Tanker-246 were out of service for 3 days. Town was then protected by ET-146 (24 years old), E-146 (30 years old) and T-146 (31 years old).
