

At long last, the **9/11 Memorial Museum** has opened. The museum's 110,000 square feet is located in the archaeological heart of the World Trade Center site.

The Museum: The National 9/11 Memorial & Museum is the country's principal institution concerned with exploring the implications of the events of 9/11, documenting the impact of those events and exploring 9/11's continuing significance. Multimedia displays, artifacts and narratives commemorate the lives of each & every victim of both the 2001 & 1993 attacks.

The Memorial: The names of every person who died in the terrorist attacks are inscribed in bronze around the twin memorial pools.


