Budget Referendum Results

Question 1 – Shall the recommendation of the Board of Finance to appropriate \$27,979,120 for the total town and school expenditures for the fiscal year of July 01, 2009 through June 30, 2010, be approved?

Total ballots received (including 13 absentee ballots)	1,113
Total votes in favor of the budget as submitted (yes votes)	868
Total votes opposed to the budget as submitted (no votes)	245

This is the highest differential since 1982 when the Town first started voting on the budget by referendum.

Question 2 –As a non-binding, advisory only opinion, do you feel that the recommendation to appropriate \$7,202,864 for town operations only is too low or too high?

Total votes too high	417
Total votes too low	497

Question 3 – As a non-binding, advisory only opinion, do you feel that the recommendation to appropriate \$20,776,256 for school operations only is too low or too high?

Total votes too high	327
Total votes too low	672

Results for questions 2 and 3 DO NOT include 13 absentee ballots
