 - § 5-18 Emergency Preparedness Advisory Council.
 - [Amended 11-6-2013, effective 11-6-2013]
 - (a) There shall be a Civil **Emergency** Preparedness Advisory Council of nine members serving two-year terms. Five of these members shall consist of the Resident Trooper, the Fire Chief, the Superintendent of Schools, ~~the Superintendent of Highways~~, the **Director of Public Works, and the CERT Team Leader.**
 - . The Council shall have the powers and duties of Civil Preparedness Advisory Councils prescribed by state statutes.
 - (b) The appointive authority may suspend residency requirements for the following personnel: Resident Trooper, Fire Chief, Superintendent of Schools, ~~Superintendent of Highways~~, **Director of Public Works, and the CERT Team Leader.**

§ 17-1 Establishment.
