Compliments on the recent townwide postcard about social service assistance.

Senior Center: Maureen reported Senior Center statistics: from July 1 2022 to June 31 2023 there were 144 new Senior Center members, average 27 member visits per day, 442 active members. Dial a Ride clients 72.

With "Somers Comes Together" grant money 2 more permanent pickleball nets will be set up. One permanent net is already in place. Pickleball program is growing. There will be a tournament in October.

Home Helpers monthly lunch will be limited to 30 people.

Hiring is in process for another part time bus driver. Pat Perry is officially retiring.

Eileen asked about the faulty wheelchair lift on both buses. There is a manually operated option but both will be repaired.

Donna distributed a flier about the Senior resource fair in Vernon on Oct. 21. Eileen asked if there would be a senior bus available. Donna will check with a driver.

There will be a flu clinic in October at the Senior Center.

There will be a Halloween party on Oct. 31. Lunch and karaoke.

Donna distributed the Somers Senior Center Policies and Procedures Manual asking committee members to look at it and suggest changes. Completed manual will be approved by the Selectmen and town attorney. All new Senior Center members will be given a copy and be asked to sign that they received it.
