## TOWN OF SOMERS BOARD OF FINANCE REGULAR MEETING MONDAY, JULY 27, 2009

#### I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Jim Persano called the regular meeting to order, at 7:10pm. Members present were Steve Krasinski, George Warner and Marilyn Pronovost. Also present were Water Pollution Control Authority (WPCA) Chairman Jim Botellio, First Selectmen David Pinney and Finance Director Greg Simmons.

Mr. Persano made a motion to take the agenda out of order to hear from those present regarding transfer requests. The board unanimously agreed.

Mr. Botellio explained that the transfer request from the WPCA for \$255,377 would enable the town to proceed with the project for water lines on Sunset Drive. This project is funded in a large part by the Federal Governments Clean Water Fund, which passes through the State's Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). The funds have been approved for the Somers project by the DEP for 100% of project costs excluding the cost of fire hydrants. The current estimate for hydrants is \$16,400. This amount could be less depending upon the recommendation by the Town's Fire Department for the number of hydrants needed.

The members of the Board felt we should have more solid assurance from the State that the funds will be provided for reimbursement and asked Mr. Botellio to obtain written confirmation of this fact. Mr. Botellio agreed to seek the confirmation and indicated that with the approval for the remainder of the design costs (\$12,700), the project could proceed pending the written confirmation for reimbursement.

Mr. Warner made a motion seconded by Mr. Krasinski to approve a reimbursement appropriation of \$12,700 to Water Construction account #66-10-372.0 which will be reimbursed by the State. The motion was approved unanimously.

Mr. Krasinski made a motion seconded by Mr. Warner to approve a reimbursement appropriation of \$242,677 contingent on the Town receiving a written confirmation from the State Department of Environmental Protection that Federal Clean Water funds will be available for reimbursement to the Town. The motion was approved unanimously.

Chief Pagani provided some explanations for the Fire Department transfer requests to the Board.

Mr. Warner questioned why there was so much capacity in the Health Insurance line item to cover these requests. Mr. Simmons said the health insurance estimate assumes traditional coverage for eligible participants; unfilled positions, waivers of coverage and employees electing the health savings high deductible account all save the town money in this line item.

Mr. Persano asked why there were overages in the heat and fuel line items. Chief Pagani said the Town entered into contracts with vendors for these fuels at rates that were higher than those anticipated at the time the budget was adopted. Mr. Simmons added that the lock in for heat was at \$3.65 a gallon and this caused problems with heat line items throughout the budget.

Chief Pagani said the current year's budget may not be sufficient for vehicle fuel depending on the pricing but he would stay within the bottom line budget for the Fire Department even if he has to cut back on other items to do so.

Mr. Krasinski made a motion seconded by Mrs. Pronovost to accept transfer #63 (see detail below). The motion was approved unanimously.

## VII. OTHER

Mr. Pinney told the Board that the Town would be turning back approximately \$250,000 to the fund balance this year from the operating budget. This was achieved by closely monitoring costs throughout the year and will in effect off-set the amount needed for utilization in the current year's budget.

Mr. Pinney explained the transfer request for the Trappe property that the Board did not approve during that section of the agenda. This request is for property that abuts Town owned, State forest owned and Northern Connecticut Land Trust (NCLT) property and completes the protection of Bald Mountain. Two appraisals were obtained to verify the value of the 137 acre parcel. The purchase is being made with the Town's share of the costs coming from the Open Space Fund, which is restricted specifically for this type of purchase. The remaining share of the total cost of \$550,000.00 is being paid from NCLT and the State of Connecticut.

Mr. Krasinski made a motion seconded by Mrs. Pronovost to approve the appropriations transfer to Open Space Land Acquisition for \$137,500.00 from the Open Space Fund. The motion was approved unanimously.

# VIII. ADJOURNMENT

Chairman Persano made a motion seconded by Mr. Krasinski to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 pm. The motion was approved unanimously.
