3. FY 2020 Budget Discussion, Recommendations, and Decisions

Michael Marinaccio presented an update on budget proceedings. Selectman Devlin spoke to a letter the Board penned, highlighting three cuts in the budget totaling \$75,000 total for the Town.

Superintendent Czapla spoke to the budget of the Board of Education and after discussions agreed to reduce their budget by \$30,000 based on a new contract price for oil.

Jim Persano made a motion to approve the FY20 budget for \$33,856,417 to send to public hearing, seconded by Tom Mazzoli.

The Board discussed potential cuts that were presented earlier in the night and this amount did not include those cuts.

A call to vote was made. The motion was defeated 5-0.

Jim Persano made a motion to approve the FY20 Budget for \$33,751,417 to send to public hearing, seconded by Bill Salka. There was no further discussion and a unanimous decision followed.

4. Budget Flyer, Content Finalization, and Approval Bill Salka made a motion to approve the budget flyer as presented, seconded by Tim Geib. There was no further discussion and a unanimous decision followed.

5. Adjournment

Bill Salka made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:05 pm, seconded by Tom Mazzoli. There was no further discussion and a unanimous decision followed.
