We went out to bid and received three responses. The pricing is based on the lowest bidder.

**6. Effect on delivery of service/cost of service if acquisition is delayed.**

Our current alarm monitoring vendor is Tolland County Mutual Aid (TN). In September of 2020 we received notice that TN is getting out of the alarm monitoring business. Effective June 30, 2021, they will no longer monitor our fire and security systems. We requested bids from local and state bid vendors for monitoring services. We received three bids and all bidders noted that our back up (second) connection system is out of date and unreliable. This assertion is in agreement with our experiences of the last three years. We have been experiencing power outages more frequently, and when these outages occur, we experience many false alarms which mandate a response from Fire, Police, and Public Works Departments. These false alarms come at a time when these three departments are busy with storm response. Our current alarm connections consist of a primary line which is on our VOIP system and a secondary line made up of cox and Frontier hard lines which are unreliable at best.



1. **Assignment and Delegation:** CUSTOMER may not assign its rights or delegate its obligations under this Agreement, in whole or in part, without the prior written consent of TPC. TPC may assign its right to receive payment to a third party.
2. CUSTOMER shall be responsible for maintaining all liability and property insurance. No insurer or other third party will have any subrogation rights against TPC.
3. **Hazardous Materials:** CUSTOMER represents and warrants that, except as otherwise disclosed in this in the areas where TPC will undertake work or provide Services, there are no: (a) materials or substances classified as toxic or hazardous either (i) on or within the walls, floors, ceilings or other structural components or (ii) otherwise located in the work area, including asbestos or presumed asbestos-containing materials, formaldehyde, containers or pipelines containing petroleum products or hazardous substances, etc.; (b) situations subject to special precautions or equipment required by federal, state or local health or safety regulations; or (c) unsafe working conditions.
4. Should any part of

the system or any Equipment be damaged by fire, water, water leakage, freezing pipes, lightning, acts of God, third parties or any other cause beyond the control of TPC, any repairs or replacement shall be paid for by CUSTOMER.

8. Indemnity and Limitation of Liability: TPC agrees to indemnify and hold CUSTOMER and its agents and employees harmless from all claims for bodily injury and property damages to the extent such claims result from or arise under TPC negligent actions or willful misconduct in its performance of the Services. Provided, that nothing in this Article shall be construed or understood to alter the limitations of liability contained in this Article or the indemnification contained in SECTION 4. In no event shall TPC be liable for any special, incidental, indirect, speculative, remote, or consequential damages arising from, relating to, or connected with the services, equipment, materials, or any goods provided hereunder. Such indemnity obligation is valid only to the extent CUSTOMER gives TPC **reasonably prompt notice** in writing of any such claims and permits TPC, through counsel of its choice, to answer the claims and defend any related suit.
9. The parties further agree that TPC is not an insurer; that the Services purchased herein is designed only to reduce the risk of loss; that CUSTOMER chose the level and scope of services being provided by TPC from a variety of service options; that TPC will not be held liable for any loss, in tort or otherwise, which may arise from the failure of the system(s) and/or service(s) or any errors and omissions in the above referenced specifications. The parties further agree that this Agreement shall not confer any rights on the part of any person or entity not a party hereto, whether as a third-party beneficiary or otherwise.
10. Replacement of our 2001 class 8 combination Dump/Plow/Sander Truck with a class 6 smaller more useful 26,000 Dump/Sander/Plow Truck.

**3. Frequency of Use.**

This is a smaller class of dump truck to be used in "the flats" during winter operations. It is similar but a little larger than a one ton dump truck which is used every day. This truck will be use most work days and around the clock during the winter and other storm events.

Annual routine service costs during the warrantee period of five years are estimated to be \$2,500.00. After the warrantee period annual service costs are estimated to be \$5000.00 per year.

We have had much success with the International make of truck and Henderson line of winter operations products. They are very reliable and have great service and parts availability.

The vehicle will be purchased from an approved State of CT vendor previously purchased from – **MHQ of Middletown**. Municipal purchases are given a discounted rate.

**6. Effect on delivery of service/cost of service if acquisition is delayed.**

This vehicle will replace the 2011 Ford Crown Vic which is getting more difficult to repair with older parts not manufactured any longer. Also more difficult to outfit the new police equipment and accessories into the 2011 vehicle interior. Older vehicles not equipped with safer features and technology to reduce accidents and potential injuries in the event an accident occurs.

Initial vehicle pricing through vendor quote on SUV. The additional accessories cost is based on previous purchases needed to outfit the police SUV i.e. trailer hitch, gun safe/ gun rack, mount for the CF31 computer inside, etc.

**1. Description of Capital Item with all accessories, spare parts, and warranties.**

Looking to replace 6 of our oldest air packs with newer models.

The Somers Fire Department has a total of 25 air packs. These 6 packs would all go on the first due fire engine, and then the older packs would cycle to the other trucks, and the oldest packs will be removed from service.

We would like to keep all the packs on a specific truck the same make/model so our members know what to expect when they sit in that seat – and the first due fire engine holds 6 packs. This will ensure the newest packs are always on the busiest truck.

In addition, the new packs are required to provide a lot more protection to the wearer. They are designed to withstand higher temperatures, and must now be CBRN (Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear) certified, should our members ever need to respond to a terrorist or hazardous materials incident.

The new packs will include the actual air pack, bottle, spare bottle, rechargeable battery pack, and face mask.

This proposal also includes replacing the RIT (Rapid Intervention Team) pack that is used if a firefighter should become trapped or run low on air.

**2. Projected Useful Life.**

NFPA and the OSHA recommend that packs be replaced after 15 years. 17 of our 25 packs are now 12+ years old.

In addition, the SCBA bottles themselves must legally be removed from service after 15 years. This is a DOT and OSHA requirement that we must follow. Like our packs, the vast majority of our bottles are now within a few years of needing replacement.

**3. Frequency of Use.**

SCBA must be worn by firefighters at all fires and hazardous materials incidents. These new packs will be placed on the first due engine, and will see regular use several times a week.

**4. Repair Costs – stated on same basis as Useful Life.**

Repair costs for these packs should be on par with those that they are replacing. This is already a normal operating expense – which includes routine service and an annual flow test.

The new packs do have an added advantage in that they now use a rechargeable battery. Our existing SCBA units have a variety of regular alkaline (Duracell) batteries that we need to change regularly.

**5. Price/Quality Analysis.**

Four years ago, when we started to look at phasing in new SCBAs – the department brought all the major vendors in for demonstrations and obtained competitive bids. The MSA G1 style pack was selected on both performance and lower price point.

Our plan is to continue using this same make and model for consistency.

**6. Effect on delivery of service/cost of service if acquisition is delayed.**

The average age of our packs is getting older and older. Some of the packs will start to fail, and once MSA discontinues the product line, service and parts will become increasingly difficult.

We already started to implement a program in 2017 - where we replace 6 packs every 4 years. This will effectively rotate all the packs out every 16 years. This way the town will not be faced with a situation in a few years where we will need to suddenly come up with several hundred thousand dollars to replace them all at once.

It also ensures that the most used packs will always be fairly new instead of going the all at once approach, where all of our packs are brand new, and then you get to a point like we are at today where they are all getting old at the same time.

#### **7. Method of Determining Price.**

We had a competitive bid process back in 2017, and MSA met our needs at the lowest price point. At this time we are looking to stay with the same brand, which can only be sold by Firematic in our region. A quote is attached.
