Irene Percoski will be obtaining a computer from the town to enable her to type the Cemetery minutes. The computer will be equipped

with the basic programs. Tom Brewer has offered to set up the computer for her.

Carole signed one invoice to be to Vasseur. An invoice from Jonathan Appell is expected anytime.

6. HAMILTON HOUSE

Carole Pyne presented to the committee a book of the restoration of the Hamilton House. It contains before and after pictures and will be retained in the Treasurer's office. The work was completed by Jonathan Appell.

7. CONTINUED CEMETERY RESTORATION

Jonathan Appell has completed restoration of 15 gravestones and monuments in the North Cemetery. Also, the Pease monument in the West Cemetery has been cleaned by Jim Jenkins.
