Describe the nature and purpose of proposed regulated activity, request for acceptance of a permitted use as of right or a nonregulated use, map or regulation amendment, or other activity requiring review by the Commission or its Agent: The existing property has been managed for wildlife, specifically early successional/young forest habitat. Due to impact of drought/gypsy moth, many oak trees have died within the past year. The harvest area will be the same area as previously permitted, using the same roads that were previously permitting, and will be outside of the inland wetlands and water courses.

2. Describe how the proposed activity affects wetlands, watercourses, and the regulated areas. Describe the nature of the affected resources, including their function, and list any wetlands of special interest (vernal pool, marsh, bog, etc.) : The proposed logging activity will not affect wetlands, watercourses, or regulated areas.

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

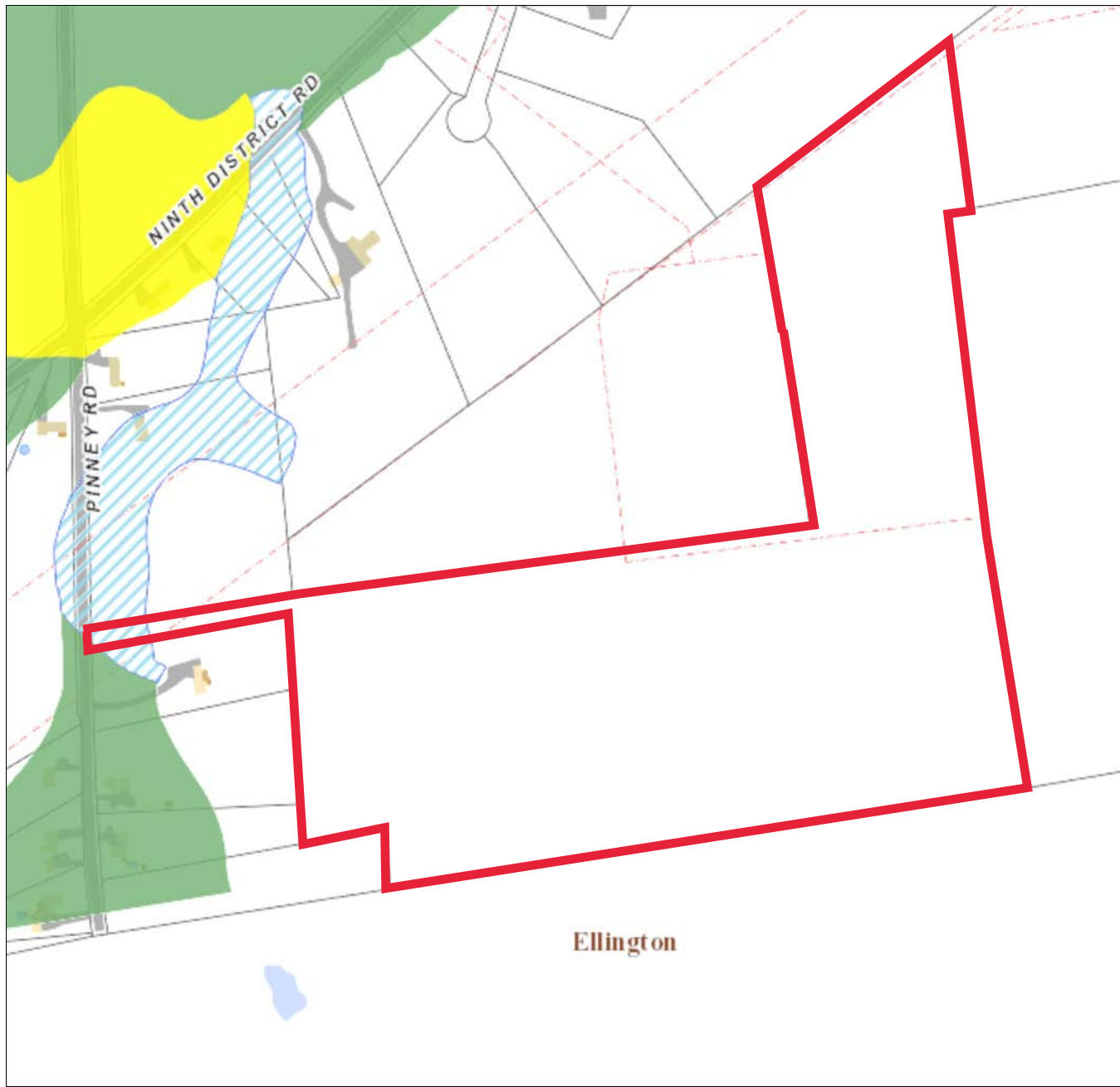

Geographic Information System (GIS)



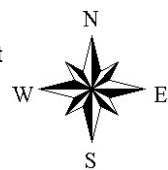

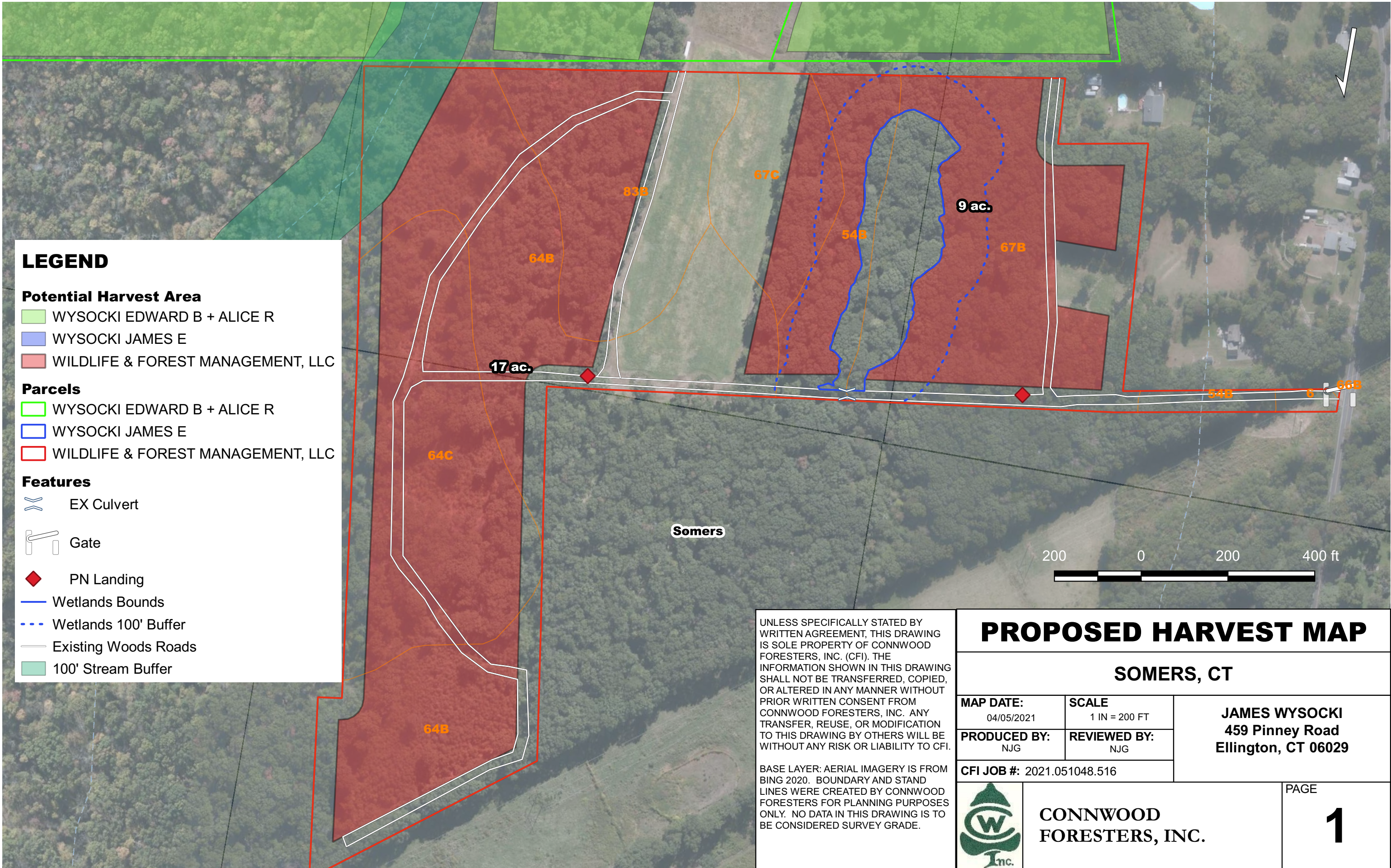

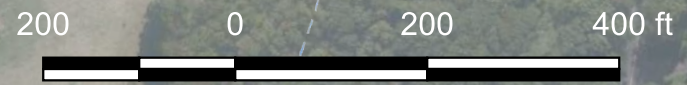
