**REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 6, 2012  
Town Hall Lower Level Conference Room 7 P.M.**

**I. CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Todd Whitford at 7:03 p.m. Commissioners in attendance were: Greg Genlot, Karl Walton, Vice-Chairperson Joan Formeister, and Candace Aleks, Secretary. Also present: Wetlands Agent, David Askew.

**III. NEW BUSINESS**

**1. Application #655 Applicants, Ken and Nicole Long for an in-ground swimming pool in the upland review area. 70 Scully Rd.**

Russell Miller from Juliano Pools presented plans for an in-ground pool. Mr. Miller said the area to be excavated is down slope from the wetlands. Mr. Askew requested that a revised plan be submitted to show the distance from the edge of the disturbance to the wetland.. He also recommended that the stockpile should not be close to the wetlands.

**2. Application # 656 Applicant, Zachary Szymko for Owner, Town of Somers. Construction of a dock on Mill Pond; 44 and 59 School Street.**

Boy Scout, Zachary Szymko presented a plan to build a dock on Mill Pond that will be 4.5 feet wide by 24 feet long, constructed out of pressure treated pine with galvanized/stainless hardware. Mr. Askew will consult with the Public Works Director to insure that there are no conflicts with existing access to the pond.. Scout Szymko mentioned that various companies and private citizens in the community were making donations for the materials.

*Karl Walton made the motion for the Commission to provide \$300.00 towards the project. Greg Genlot seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion passed.*

**3. Application #657 James Patsun, Septic System and associated grading within the upland review area. 75 Franklin Woods Dr.**

Mr. Askew explained that no permit was required because there is no activity in the upland review area.

**4. Appointment of Conservation Commission member to POCD Committee.**

*Joan Formeister nominated Karl Walton to be the Conservation Commission's Representative to the POCD. Todd Whitford seconded. All were in favor and the motion passed.*
