Re: Wetland delineation 520 Hall Hill Road, Watchaug Road, Somers, CT - Jarmoc Farms JR Russo plan dated 3/11/22 - job number 2021-095 - revised 4/19/22

To Whom it may concern:

On April 14, 2022, I conducted a wetland delineation to identify the Connecticut regulated wetland soils on the above referenced parcel located at 520 Hall Hill Road, in the Town of Somers, CT. This delineation was conducted for the purposes of identifying wetland soils associated with the development of proposed barns as depicted on the above referenced Barn Plot Plan. The limits of flagging consisted of only the regulated soils and watercourses adjacent to the proposed building.

To the north of the proposed barns is a watercourse flagged as CWC (center of Watercourse) A1 to CWC A4 where the flow dissipates into the ground and , therefore, ends.

To the west the flags are labeled WB1 to WB11 delineating Raypol wetland soils. The Raypol series consists of very deep, poorly drained soils formed in loamy over sandy and gravelly outwash.

TAXONOMIC CLASS: Coarse-loamy over sandy or sandy-skeletal, mixed, active, acid, mesic Aeric Endoaquepts

To the south of the proposed barns a watercourse is identified as CWC1 to CWC3 by flagging and said watercourse continues easterly as shown on plan.

The inspection for wetlands soils was flagged in accordance with the standards of the National Cooperative Soil Survey and the definition of wetlands as found in the Connecticut General Statutes, Chapter 440, Section 22A-38. All flagging was fluorescent pink and blue and numbered as shown on the plan.


