1. Describe the nature and purpose of proposed regulated activity, request for acceptance of a permitted use as of right or a nonregulated use, map or regulation amendment, or other activity requiring review by the Commission or its Agent:
Applicant desires to clear forest to create farm land. Applicant had a soil scientist test and learned of wetland soils. Applicant seeks a determination of the commission, that he may clear in the wetland delinated zone, and within the
upland review area, as this is an agricultural use
2. Describe how the proposed activity affects wetlands, watercourses, and the regulated areas. Describe the nature of the affected resources, including their function, and list any wetlands of special interest (vernal pool, marsh, bog, etc.): There is no flowing water in this area or active wetland, this particular area will see water pool during heavy rain and as a result has developed wetland soils. No soil will be removed or added to this particular area. Intention is not to
farm in the wetland area, but to clear trees there to provide sunlight in the adjacent reclaimed farm land.
3. Describe measures that will be taken to minimize the impact on wetlands, watercourses and the regulated areas, including proposed erosion and sedimentation controls and other management practices or mitigation measures:
The applicant will place appropriate silt fencing and take other measures as the Commission advises.
