After discussion it was suggested that we open January thru April . Maximum seating would be 50 attendees(if approved), required masks, vaccine cards, advanced registration, no food/beverages. Pat motioned and Giselle seconded. Approved unanimously.

Discussion of concert series-such positive feedback, so well attended and the community loved the three season series. Giselle suggested we could perhaps kickoff our summer series by adding "Juneteenth". Commission agreed it would be a good addition. Giselle suggested maybe a movie night at the Gazebo. She will look into it with Enfield who does it-cost of projector, etc. Suggestion that maybe the Boy Scouts could do a project to build the screen. Dave will check with group he knows in Springfield also.

New Business: Suggestion we modify our sponsor letter next year with guidelines for COVID. Ann Murphy stated we had 5 new sponsors for our spring concerts and 9 new sponsors for our summer/fall concerts. Our 2021 sponsorship campaign was most successful and encouraging. The 2022 meeting calendar was presented. Dave motioned to accept and Bev seconded. So approved.
