Todd Rolland - Business as usual at DPW. Playground and bathrooms at Field Rd. park are open again. Cleaned and sanitized daily. Made up a cleaning plan and contact person for each town building for when buildings are reopened. Gas pump at the Field Rd fuel station is down. Please use the one at DPW. Drive through rabies clinic Sat 6/6 at DPW.

Steve Jacobs - 297 total cases in Somers. 37 residents and 260 are at the prison. 5 fatalities. Nothing new from the DOC in over a week. Pilot testing is on the horizon, possibly partner with JMH for this. Updated executive order from the governor allowing gatherings of 10 indoors and 25 outdoors

Brian Czapla - Thanked all those involved in the parade for the high school seniors, the event went very well. Graduation is set for June 11th at Mansfield Drive In. Track is nearing completion, should be done by the end of the month.

Mike Hevey - June 10th is a teach parade throughout the town. June 15th pistol permits and fingerprinting will be available again. Turnpike Rd project has started.

Karen Hocking - CERT members participated in mask distribution event in Enfield this morning.
