

The Somers fully vaccinated rate has increased 5.48% since December 2021.

Numbers of cases for the past seven days: 6 Positivity rate for the last seven days: 14%

\*A person is considered fully vaccinated if he/she has completed a primary vaccination series by receiving 2 doses of the Pfizer, Moderna, or Novavax vaccines or 1 dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine and recommended boosters. The definition changed in June to include boosters.

Booster Update; the FDA authorized bivalent formulations of the Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines for use as a single booster dose at least two months after completing primary or booster vaccination.

- September 2, 2022, for people 12 years of age and older
- October 12, 2022, for people aged 5–11


