Nothing has come up.

### 4.1.2. Review Condition of the Facilities and work orders

Mostly turnovers but also seasonal change over to air conditioning

Ground care is new crew from the contractor who struggles with staffing, so challenges in keeping the activity in line with our requirements.

### 4.1.3. Review Financial Condition

Continued vacancies create pressure on the revenue side but expenses have been anticipated and within budget for the most part so both phases in reasonable positions.

### 4.1.4. Review Resident Services Coordinator's activities

Hoping to set up some outside activities in July, but challenges to provide some shade or other weather accommodations. People seem ready for increased socializing.

### 4.2. Review of COVID-19 safety provisions and access to community spaces

We have eased off surface cleaning to once a week. Staff cleaning surfaces in the offices. No mask requirements.

# 4.3. PILOT abatement

The lawyers for the town and Woodcrest have been communicating and hopefully working toward mutual agreement on abatement language.
