I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Secretary Dan Fraro at 7:35 p.m. In attendance was members George Van Tasel, Mark Marschall and Stephen Getman. Also in attendance was Town Sanitarian Steven Jacobs.

II. MINUTES 6/3/14

Member Stephen Getman made a motion, seconded by George Van Tasel, to approve the minutes dated 6/3/13. All in favor, motion carried.

III. SOMERSVILLE WPCF MAINTENANCE

Mr. Jacobs reported that the flow sensor is still scheduled for installation by United. Maher Corp. inspected the UV system sensor and board and subsequently found no problems with the equipment. Bacteria kills are very good, yet UV intensity reading is still reading low and will be retested. Mr. Jacob is meeting with DEEP on 7/3 to see if intensity reading is really a concern and if it can be deleted from the permit. Members suggested the older board be saved and to inquire whether the new one could possibly be sent back. Sanitarian Jacobs indicated that he would look into doing that.

IV. CORRESPONDANCE/AUDIENCE APRTICIPATION

1. As requested – a letter was sent to Hinckley Construction asking for a schedule to fix the faulty valve installation and to have the wet well coated as was required by the WPCF upgrade specifications. The Authority requested the matter be referred to the Town Attorney if there is no response within 30 days.
2. Town sanitarian Jacobs informed members that the year-end collection was in excess of \$98,000.
