REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
June 5, 2018

**I. CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 7:32 pm by Chairman, James Botellio. Other members present were: Stephen Getman, Mark Marschall, George VanTasel, Jr. Charles Colby and Daniel Fraro. Also present was Steven Jacobs, Town Sanitarian.

**II. MINUTES APPROVAL**

**III. SOMERSVILLE WPCF – UV DISINFECTION**

Mr. Jacobs reported that we had problems with the start-up of the UV Disinfection system this season. We had two failed test, both of which were Ok upon retesting. We have consulted with Trojan Technologies and had Maher Corp. replace the monitoring board and sensor. The bulbs had been replaced prior to start-up, so all the equipment is now new. Thus far, no explanation for the failures have been confirmed. Mr. Jacobs will check with Hazardville Water Co. for any changes in water treatment, which may have contributed to the problem. Mr. Jacobs also reported that the pumps on Quality Ave. are in need of a rebuild and he is getting pricing for that.

**IV. CORRESPONDENCE/AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION**

- Mr. Jacobs sent an Invitation to Bid out for the cleaning of the septic tanks on the Maple Ridge System and one for the Somersville WPCF.
- Mr. Jacobs reported that the CT-DEEP has sent notice for renewal of the Somersville WPCF discharge permit.
