

**TOWN OF SOMERS

REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
September 11, 2018
7:30 PM -TOWN HALL**

I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Chairman, James Botellio. Other members present were: Mark Marschall, Charles Colby and Stephen Getman. Also present was Steven Jacobs, Town Sanitarian.

II. MINUTES APPROVAL

The minutes of August 14, 2018 were reviewed:

A motion was made by Mr. Colby to approve the minutes as written. 2nd by Mr. Marschall, all in favor, motion passed.

III. SOMERSVILLE WPCF – Maintenance

Mr. Jacobs reported that the new transducer has been installed at the Quality Ave. Pump Sta. and the pumps have been cleaned. The UV disinfection system is still having problems. Results for light blocking elements did not reveal any unusual discharge into the system. It is now believed to be a growth within the sandbeds due to the extended hot weather. Mr. Jacobs has reached out to CT-DEEP help resolve the problem, but response to voice and email has been very slow. They still seem resistant to using chlorine as a supplement to the UV disinfection.

Mr. Jacobs also reported that Skip’s Wastewater was unable to clean the mains on Shaker Rd. because the manholes had been paved over. They have since been located and dug out and will be raised this week.
