The Authority wants to discuss our options with the town attorney, as to why DEEP is requiring de-chlorination when other town are not. They would like to have a meeting with DEEP and have Atty. Carl Landolina attend. Mr. Jacobs will talk to Carl and attempt to set up a meeting.
