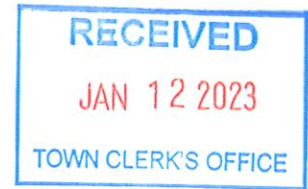


TOWN OF SOMERS

CALL TO ORDER. The Regular Meeting of the Somers WPCA was called to order at 7:00 pm by Stephen Getman Chairman. Other members present were: Emily Dreyer, Tim Vecchiarelli, Dan Fraro, Mark Folsom. Also present was Daniel Parisi, WPCA Superintendent. Absent – Mark Marschall and Duane Mason

- I. MINUTES. The minutes of the Regular Meeting of December 6, 2022 were reviewed, with amendments. A motion was made by Emily Dreyer to approve the minutes, seconded by Tim Vecchiarelli, all in favor, motion passed.
