- On Main Street (Rt. 190) from Somersville to the town center.
- On Vision Boulevard (School / Library complex) from Maple B. Avery Middle School to the High School.
- On South Road (Rt. 83, south of Main Street) from Main Street (Rt. 190) south to Geissler's supermarket.
- On Springfield Road (Rt. 83, north of Main Street) from the end of the sidewalk across from DG Graphic north to Michele Drive.
- On Battle Street north from Center Cemetery to Turnpike Road.
- On Main Street (Rt. 190), east from Eleanor Road to Scully Road.
