

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals addressed to the Public Works Department for the following contract will be received at the Town Clerk's Office, 600 Main Street, Somers, Connecticut 06071, until 11:00 a.m. on June 7, 2023, at which time they will be opened publicly and read in the Selectmen Conference Room of the Town Hall.

PLEASANT VIEW DRIVE ROADWAY & DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS

The work to be performed under this contract includes reclaiming and repaving Pleasant View Drive and installing a new underdrain along the edge of the road. The scope of work includes reclaiming and repaving approximately 1,280 lineal feet of roadway and 1,050 lineal feet of underdrain. The project consists of providing all labor, materials, machinery, tools, equipment, and other means of construction necessary and incidental to the completion of the work shown on the plans and described in the specifications, including, but not necessarily limited to, the following: demolition of existing curb, reclamation of existing pavement and base material, installation of supplemental process aggregate base, replacement of existing catch basin tops, repaving roadway, installation of new cape cod curb, installation of underdrain, installation of new bituminous driveway aprons, landscape restoration, and field verifying.

This is a prevailing wage project. This contract is also subject to state set-aside and contract compliance requirements, including the Connecticut Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of 61 days after the opening of bids without approval and written consent of the Town of Somers.

Information for Bidders, Bid Forms, specifications, and other Bidding Documents will be available as of May 8, 2023, to be downloaded from the town website: www.somersct.gov.

A Pre-Bid Meeting (non-mandatory) will be held with the Director of Public Works at 10:00 a.m., prevailing time, on May 24, 2023, at the project site, Pleasant View Drive in Somers.

The Town reserves the right to amend or terminate this invitation to bid, waive any informality, omission, or technical defect in the Bid Form, and to reject any or all proposals or to accept the proposal deemed most satisfactory to the Town of Somers, if it is in the public interest to do so.
