Post-Election Audit of Nov. 3, 2020, General Election

State law mandates that 5% of all voting precincts have their machine totals audited following any election or primary. A total of 743 voting precincts were used during the election held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. 38 districts were selected. Offices on the ballot that will be subject to the audit were also selected in a drawing by the Secretary of the State. The offices subject to audit are Representative in Congress, State Senator, and State Representative.

The election conducted at the Somers Town Hall was chosen as a polling place to be audited.

This will serve as notification that the Post-Election Audit of the November 3, 2020, General/Presidential election will be held on Monday, November 30, 2020, beginning at 9:00 AM in the Somers Town Hall Auditorium located at 600 Main Street, Somers, Connecticut.

Public Act 07-194 provides that the audit “shall be open to public inspection.”

CDC Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) recommendations for election polling locations will be followed while conducting the audit. All staff, auditors, and observers shall be required to wear a facemask or cloth face covering that covers his or her mouth and nose while in the Somers Town Hall.
