TRAFFIC CONTROL REQUIREMENTS

- 1.) When excavations, construction, or repair of or on any public roadway, street or sidewalk, or the destruction of any building within the Town of Somers, (herein after referred to as "Repair Work") creates or may create a hazard to public safety, the Police Administrator will be notified. The Police Administrator, Director of Public Works or Director of Land Use may direct the person(s) so engaged to provide uniform Police Officers, Certified Flaggers, or appropriate barricades with barricade warning Lights.
- 2.) This rule requires the use of uniformed Police Officers for traffic control on the following roads in the Town of Somers (unless otherwise authorized by the Police Administrator to use Certified Flaggers or appropriate barricades with barricade warning lights):

- Additional Roads may be included/added at the discretion of the Somers Resident Troopers Office.
- 3.) The Police Administrator may require that the person(s) engaged in Repair Work first utilize Police Officers. The expense of such police protection shall be paid by the entity engaged in such Repair Work at rates determined by the Town.
- 4.) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this rule, any Repair Work performed by the Connecticut Department of Transportation, the Town of Somers or any of its offices or agents or initiated by the Town of Somers or any of its offices or agents, may utilize properly equipped and trained Municipal employees or agents of the Municipality as Flaggers.
