

Presidential Election 2020
November 03, 2020

Numerous questions are being raised concerning the process of obtaining an Application for the Absentee Ballot or voting in-person on November 03, 2020.

The Secretary of State's office is scheduled to mail an Application for an Absentee Ballot to every registered voter within the Town of Somers by mid-September. In order to receive an Absentee Ballot, please complete the Application, sent by the State, as soon as it is received. The completed Application is to be mailed or placed in the Town of Somers Drop-Box located on the left-hand side to the entry of Town Hall.

Please complete all the sections of the Application which apply and sign the Application to insure a Ballot is mailed. The Ballot will be sent from the Town Clerk's Office to either the home address or mailing address as indicated on the Application.

Residents have the option to either receive a ballot in the mail or vote in person the day of the election.

Once the Ballot has been completed, it may be mailed through the USPS or placed in the secure permanently affixed Official Absentee Ballot Drop Box. The Official Ballot Drop-Box is located on the left-hand side of the entry to the Town Hall. The Town Clerk's office staff are the only individuals authorized to open and retrieve the completed ballots. The ballots are then secured in the Town Clerk vault for security.

The recommendation of the Town Clerk's office is to complete both the application and ballot as soon as possible and place the completed mail-in ballot in the Official Ballot Drop-Box outside the entry to Town Hall.
