**Budget Referendum**

**Date, Time and Location**

The Budget Referendum will be held on Tuesday, May 11, 2021. All voting will be conducted at the Town Hall Auditorium during the hours of 6:00 am and 8:00 pm. Please be prepared to present proper identification such as a Driver's License. All voters will be required to wear a mask and maintain social distancing while in the Town Hall voting area.

**Absentee Ballots**

Absentee Ballots are available in the Town Clerk's Office beginning May 5, 2021 for the 2021-2022 Budget Referendum. Absentee ballots for a referendum can only be issued to individuals **applying in person** to the Town Clerk's Office. Absentee Ballots **will not be mailed**.

**Eligibility to Vote**

Any person who is an elector of the Town of Somers may vote and any United States citizen eighteen years or more who, jointly or severally, is liable to the Town of Somers for taxes assessed against him/her on an assessment of not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) on the last completed Grand List of such Town.
