Is a bid bond required? If so, in what percent?

We did not require a bid bond in the bid package.

Please confirm that testing is to be paid for and conducted by the contractor.

Yes testing is to be paid for by the contractor and conducted by an outside engineering firm hired by the contractor.

Please confirm that the fence around the basketball court is to remain (not being replaced).

Yes, the basketball court fence is to remain.

Please confirm that the new fence around the tennis court is schedule 40.

Yes, the new fence around the tennis court is to be schedule 40.

Please clarify the new fence requirements at the tennis courts. Is the fence replaced around the existing practice wall?

Not around three existing practice walls but yes, at the common wall of the tennis and practice courts.

*Correction: Under Fencing: "The fence system will consist of 662LF of 10 foot high, black vinyl-coated steel fence..." Should read: "The fence system will consist of 672LF of 10 foot high,

The tennis courts measure 124' x 212' at the fence.

Total lineal feet of new fence is 672.

Is any work required inside the practice wall enclosure (crack repair, painting...)?

Not at this time.

Yes, the new surface shall be "feathered "down to the practice court surface.

Please advise the new colors for the BB court and Tennis courts. Tennis is currently green & purple.

Purple for the court area and green for the surrounding fields.

Please confirm the acceptable daily work hours for the project.
